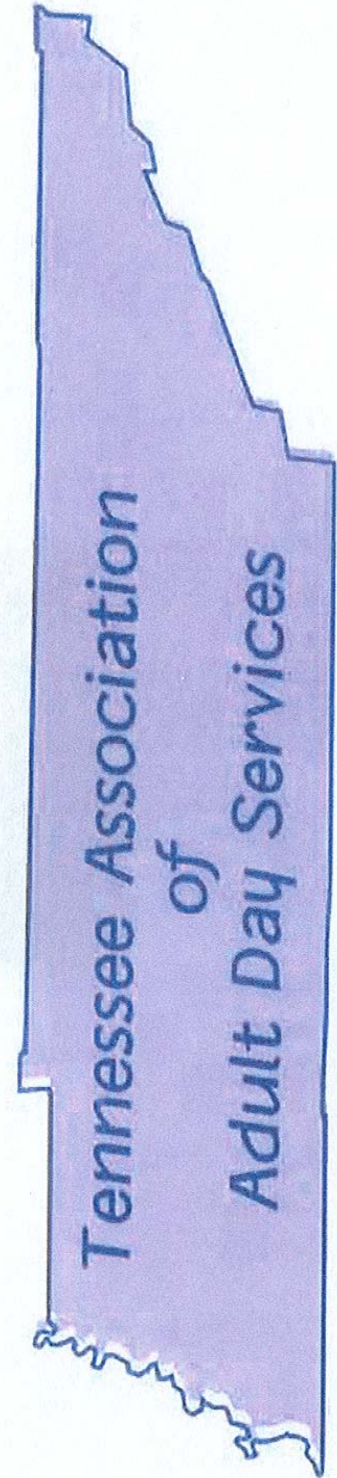

- Programs for adults who have physical, neurological or emotional problems requiring special intervention or care
- An opportunity for socialization in an accepting environment
- Activities that help cognitively or physically challenged adults maintain or improve their levels of functioning according to individual needs
- Respite for family members
- Services that divert or delay the need for institutionalized care and its associated financial and emotional costs
- Programs that provide an environment that is conducive for adults who require some supervision to explore feelings, communicate, and experience how their life can still have a positive impact
